

Saint Paul Public Schools
 Secondary Class Size Report
 2004-2005 School Year

Introduction

The following report indicates class sizes in secondary grades district-wide in Saint Paul Public Schools as of mid-October, 2004. The district-wide table shows district-wide averages for any subject area with more than twenty classes district-wide.

The report is based on the number of students scheduled to be in a classroom. If the schedule is not identical each day of the week, the number calculated is the average number of scheduled students for the week. If there are multiple levels of the same subject being taught in one class (e.g. French 4 and 5), they are reported as a single class. In some cases, additional staff share the instructional duties, either helping the teacher with the entire class or working with selected groups of students within the class.
